**Household Hints**

**PINEAPPLE PRESERVE**

Pineapple Preserve.—Pare the pineapples, and with a sharp, pointed knife extract the 'eyes'; then with a silver fork tear the fruit off the cores in pieces of moderate size. Weigh when all is stripped from the cores, and allow a pound of sugar to a of fruit; place in a kettle alternate layers of fruit and sugar until all is used, adding a scanty cup of water to every pound of sugar. Heat slowly to the boiling point, and when the fruit has been scalded three minutes, skim it and spread on a platter, returning the kettle all the syrup that drains from the fruit. Boil the syrup half an hour, skimming frequently; then add the pineapple, and boil fifteen minutes when it should be done. If the syrup is not as thick as you wish, skim out the fruit, again, and boil the syrup down to the desired consistency, cooling a little in a saucer to test its thickness, and always remembering that it will become much richer in color after it has been set away a short time. Return the fruit again for a final scalding, and set it away for use.

**FRUITED GELATINE.**

One package of flavored gelatine one pint of boiling water, canned fruit of any kind, sweetened whipped cream. Dissolve the gelatine in the boiling water and pour half of it into a bowl or mold. Arrange the fruit—peaches, pineapple, cherries, or whatever you desire—in the gelatine and set away to harden. When firm, pour in more gelatine and lay in more fruit; allow to get firm and then pour on the rest of the gelatine. When stiff, unmold and garnish with the rest of the fruit. Serve with sweetened whipped cream slightly flavored with vanilla. After a little experimenting you will be able to obtain delicious combinations, but in the beginning you will find it the best plan to use orange gelatine with oranges, cherry flavor with cherries, etc.

**Three Farmers Lose Dwellings  
Near Hillsboro**

Moncton, May 28—A terrific forest fire driven by a wind that blew a hurricane, devastated several miles of scrub woodland between Shenstone and Steevescote near Hillsboro this afternoon and evening.

At last reports the fire was still burning fiercely and running in the direction of the oil wells, though no serious danger in that direction is anticipated. Little timber of value was destroyed but three farmers lost their dwellings and other buildings. Those burned out are Murdoch Steeves, Metzler Steeves and Talbot Steeves.

Some other dwellings are reported dangerously near the fire.
