Household Hints
DENATURED ALCOHOL FOR
HOUSEKEEPING.

Housekeeping with denatured alcohol is advocated by a contemporary. It is claimed that for cooking it is cheaper and better than coal at present prices, and that much of the labor involved in caring for oil lamps is saved when alcohol is used as an illuminant. An alcohol radiator may also be used satisfactorily for heating rooms in spring and fall.

TO CLEAN OUT A CHIMNEY

When the stove pipes seem "choked up" and the fire refuses to burn, the chimney is often very dirty. Lay a piece of zinc, old or new, on a bed of coals, and the fumes arising from the burning zinc will clean both pipe and chimney of all dust and soot.

**COAL SHOULD NOT BE EX-
CLUDED FROM AIR**

Coal should be kept in a dry, airy place, and it will burn much better than if in a close, badly ventilated cellar. Coal that is excluded from the air soon gets rid of its gas, and the absence of this renders it more wasteful when burned.

STALE BREAD MADE FRESH

A stale loaf put into a closely covered tin, exposed for half an hour to a heat not exceeding that of boiling water, then taken out of the tin and allowed to cool, will be restored in appearance and properties to the state of new bread.

**KEROSENE OIL REMOVES
FINGER MARKS**

The finger marks on a door can be removed by a clean flannel cloth dipped in kerosene oil; afterwards wipe with a cloth wrung out of hot water in order to take the smell away.

**SEED CORN SHOULD BE
WELL DRIED.**

See to it that the seed corn is thoroughly dried, each ear separately, before storing for the winter advises Farm, Stock and Home.

**DO NOT LET SEED CORN
FREEZE**

See that the seed corn which you have carefully selected, and hung up or put on racks to dry is not subjected to freezing weather. Sudden weather changes may happen any time—we should guard against these—I. H. C. Service Bureau.

POTATOES AS CATTLE FEED

Potatoes may, says *Harvard's Dairyman*, be fed to dairy cows in limited quantities; twenty pounds per day is considered enough. If fed in large quantities they effect the quality of butter, making it more or less salty, and are also apt to cause the animal to scour.

AMERICAN BEAN CROP

Reports published by the *American Agriculturist*, indicate that the bean crop of New York and Michigan will be about the same as last year, but that a good deal of damage has been caused to quality by rain at harvest time. Prices run about \$2 to \$2.40 at local points.

Clover and Fertility.

Many farmers, says *Farm, Stock and Home*, have the mistaken notion that in order to build up the fertility of their land they have only to grow clover, alfalfa, cow peas, or other legumes. So far, so good, but these same men will cut the clover, the alfalfa, or the peas for hay and depend upon the roots of these plants to put nitrogen into the soil. Experience, however, has shown that legumes place much of the nitrogen fixed by them from the air into their stalks and only a small portion in the nodules on the roots. In order for legumes to do their best in building up soil fertility they must be plowed under, root, stalk, and leaf.

So Best Form of Storing Corn.

There has been considerable work done by the Experimental Stations in determining the relative value of corn fodder and silage, but there is so much variation in the fodder and also in the silage that it is hard to state just what might be expected.

Good bright corn fodder in the early fall is a very appetizing and nutritious food for all classes of farm animals. The trouble with the stover is that unless it is carefully housed, loses anywhere from 25 to 40 per cent, of its feeding value from exposure. If it is cut up and put into the silo in the fall in the proper manner, it will be just as good next spring when grass comes as it was when put up in the fall, or perhaps a little better if any thing. The silo is certainly the most economical method of storing feed for all kinds of farm animals.—I. H. C. Service Bureau.
