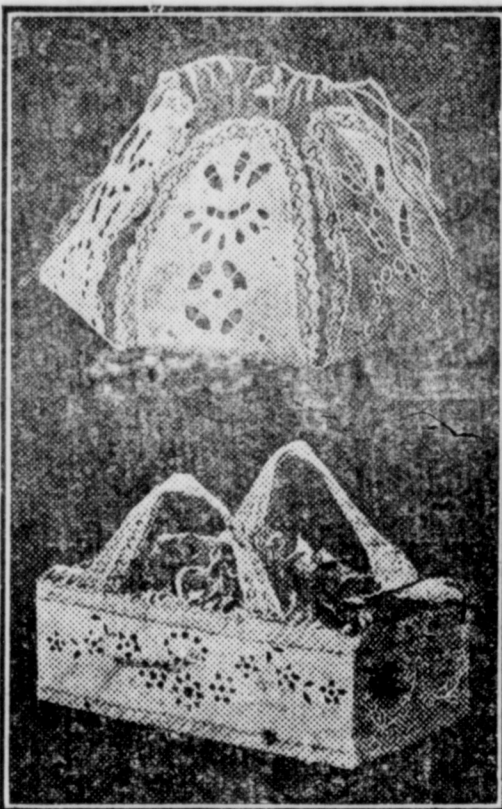

One ingenious woman has found that dental floss is the very best medium for stringing pearl, coral or crystal beads. This floss may be bought at any large drug store for 10 or 12 cents a spool.

To fasten the end neatly to the clasp run the floss through the end two beads, then through the ring on the clasp and back through the end two beads, knotting between the second and third heads and then cutting. This hides the knots.

Do not use a needle in stringing. If the end of the floss is not stiff enough rub the beeswax. By knotting the floss frequently between the beads only a few will drop off if the chain should ever break, thus saving the beads and perhaps avoiding a trying situation.

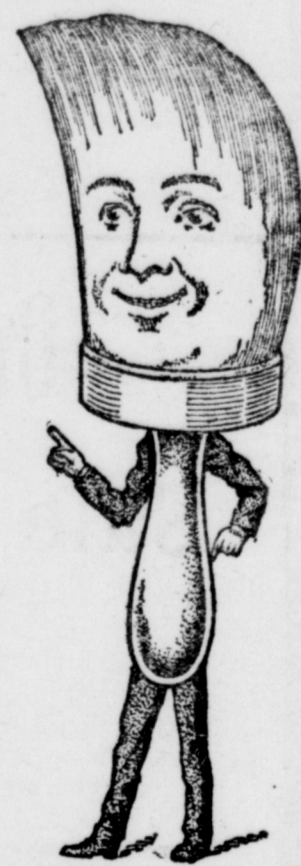
