Trinidad Agrees To Reciprocity

Agreement

Port of Spain, Trinidad, Aug. 1. - The first reciprocity agreement with Canada was carried to-day in the legislative council by 13 votes against 5 and in the chamber by a majority of one vote. The opponents of the agreement argued that it would be of no benefit to the colony outside of the sugar industry and would probably be harmful to the cocoa and cocoanut industry. The supporters of the agreement urged that its acceptance would show the imperial sentiment of Trinidad and that it would be the first step toward general trade within the British Empire.
