Buttons Of Shirred Silk.

Some of the summer frocks are trimmed with what at a little distance appear to be huge crochet buttons. On closer inspection they prove to be made of silk. Here is the secret of their making: Take a circle of silk and shir a little circle in the centre of it. Make another line of shirring a little distance from this circle and continue shirring the silk in circles until you have a piece of shirred silk big enough to cover your button mould. The shir strings should be carried to the wrong side of the silk—the side next the button mould—and fastened securely there.

SKIMMILK TO CALVES.

Calves need some feed in addition to skim milk, in order to replace the fat. Cook whole flax seed, or flax seed meal, and feed about a double handful at a feed mixed in the milk. If the oil meal or flax seed cannot be secured, use ground corn and oats, preferably, or ground corn and barley. In raising skim milk calves, one should dilute the whole milk with skim milk at the rate of an additional quart each week, so that at six weeks the calves should be on skim milk without any whole milk. The only extra precaution to be observed in feeding separator milk is not to feed while the foam is on it.

Remembers Burning Of Moscow.

Two of the oldest women and one of oldest men in the world are inmates of the Home of the Daughters of Jacob, a Jewish benevolent institution in New York for old persons of that faith who have no other place in which to live.

Of the women Ettel Polansky was a child when Bonaparte became Emperor of the French; when the battle of Trafalgar was fought and Lord Nelson met his death; when Fulton made his first steamboat voyage on the Hudson; when Napoleon Bonaparte led his army on the disastrous march to Moscow; when Commodore Perry won his victory on Lake Erie.

Born in Moscow 109 years ago, this woman, in whose lifetime so much of the world's history has been made, can recall when the French Emperor entered Moscow with the Grand Army and when the city in flames, he was driven out. Through a Yiddish interpreter she volubly related how she remembered seeing the French soldiers rolling wine casks from the burning wine shops into the streets. Later she was taken by her parents to Warsaw, and again saw the French troops in that city.

The Strawberry Season.

A method of canning strawberries, which is probably unknown to many, is described by one who has tried it with the most pleasing results.

After hulling and washing the berries place in jars and stand in a tub or boiler lined with a large cloth, letting cloth hang over the edge all around. Make a syrup and pour this over the fruit and seal jars. Then fill the tub with boiling water, cover over with the cloth, and let stand until cold.

Preserving Strawberries Whole.

Another way; Have the fruit as fresh and firm as possible, not too ripe, and do not wash unless absolutely necessary, and then, by pouring water through the berries laid in a colander, letting them drain, and bur quickly. When prepared fill glass jars about two-thirds full with the fruit, put into a preserving kettle one pound of sugar and one cupful of water to each two pounds of fruit, and let come slowly to a boil; then boil for a few

the berries, filling to overflowing;  
put the covers on the jars loosely,  
and set the jars in a pan of cold  
water having a wooden rack in the  
bottom, or other protection for the  
jars, and let the water come to a  
boil, and boil until the fruit is scald-  
ing hot clear through, then screw  
down the tops tightly and leave  
until cool enough to handle, then  
dip the top of the jar into melted  
paraffin wax to further insure its  
being air-tight.
