## HOUSEHOLD.

Divinity Fudge.

This sweetne t was known first as society, then divinity fudge Boil together two cups of fine granulated sugar, half a cup of water, and half a cup of corn syrup until it reaches the hard bill degree; then pour in a fine stream into the beaten white of an egg, add a teaspoonful of vinilla or other flavoring, and a cup of broken nut meats, or candied fruit, as desired.

#### Candied Oranges.

Method Carefully peel and divide seedless oranges into sections. Make a syrup of one cup of sugar ed linens. and one-half of water. When it has boiled clear, drop in the cranges, let remain until clear, then take out carefully, drain well, then dip in bowl of granulated sugar. Lay on waxed paper to dry.

Candied Lemons

Method --- Pare nice firm lemons removing all the white ak'n, cut into rounds, then m ke syrup and prepare as directed for oranges.

Southern Corn Cake

Mix and sift three fourth of a improvement in your ferns. cupful of corn meal, one and onefourth cupfuls of flour, one-fourth cupful of sugar, one-half teaspoonful of salt and five teaspoonfuls of baking powder. Add one cupful of milk, one egg well beat in, and one and one-half tablespoonfu's of melted butter. Bake in a hot even twenty-five minutes.

Substitute for Lard.

When baking gridele cekes, instead of greasing the griddle, rub it with a small lag of salt. The cakes are just as brown, and the k tchen is not filled with the odor of burning lard.

To Keep Pickles from Molding

A few small pieces of horse radish root placed in the tops of jars or bottles will prevent mold form-WOODSTOCK ing on pickles, such as green tomate, chow-chow, or anything of that k nd. Two or three slices in the vinegar with your cucumber pick'es will answer the same purpose. Bottled horse-radish may be used if the root is not at hand.

#### Alcohol on Windows.

When washing windows in winter use a small cloth wet in alcohol. This is excelent to remove any kind of dirt on windows, and can be dried without difficulty, since they will not become frosted as when water is used.

#### To Extract a Splinter.

When a splinter has been driven deep into the hand, it can be extracted by steam without pain. Fill a wide-mouthed bottle almost to the top with hot water; then, place the injured part over the mouth of the bottle and press lightly. The suction will draw the flesh down, and in a minute or two the steam will extract the splinter and relieve the inflammation.

Alter cleaning brass or copper with salt and vinegar, rub with olive oil, and metal will not tarnish for a long time.

Iodine is a crude alkaline matter, produced by the combustion of seaweed.

During the past forty years the Chicago Orphans' Association has cared for 4,500 children, and it has preserved a careful record of what it costs to keep a child. From 1874 to 1883 the annual cost per child was \$79.98; fron, 1884 to 1893, \$88.68; from 1894 to 1903, \$101,45; from 1904 to 1913, \$140.60. We presume the management has been fairly economical, and a large institution can save in many ways by buying in quantity; but if it costs \$140 a year to keep a child, where does the man come in who is trying to raise a family of say, five children on \$12 a week? And yet we wonder why he can't pay his debts!

One of our newspaper confreres who has kept track of the matter has the following significant item in relation to Montreal: "In the month of Augthirteen were drowned, eleven were killed by street cars, six were killed at work, four were burned to death, four met death by railway accidents and one was killed by an explosion. Life in Scutari during the siege, or in Mexico in the days of the revolution, was tame compared with this." And if we had a record of the sudden deaths in Toronto by violence and accident for one month we would have a showing just about as startling.

Efficiency in labor means total abstinence. The Crown Prince of Sweden at Hessilholm in 1910 declared. "That nation which is first to free itself from the injurious effects of alcohol will thereby obtain a marked advantage over other nations in the amicable and intensive struggle for existence. I hope that our country will be the one which will first understand and secure this advantage."

These words of the Crown Prince chime with those of the German Emperor delivered at Murwick in Fetruary, 1911, "The nation which takes the smallest quantity of alcohol will win the battles of the future."-American Advance.
