Clean straw matting and rattan fur-
niture with salt water, changing the
water often. Washed in this way they
will not turn yellow.

To remove iron-mold, hold the mark
over a cup of boiling water and gently
rub in a little salt of lemon. Rinse out
carefully afterward, as it is poisonous
and likely to rot the linen.

Ornamental Hedges

Hedges are in great demand for
wind-breaks as well as for ornam-
ental purposes. The following
named shrubs are, Farm Stock and
Home says, especially adapted for
this.

In Spiraea, the Arguta is the
earliest of the whole family, bloom-
ing with the tulips, a snowdrift of
white before the leaves appear.
It retains its leaves till December
and is noted for its rich and var-
iegated foliage after the frosts,
when the whole row seems in flow-
er with the autumnal colorings.
From first to last it is very attract-
ive. It is grown from seed or
root divisions which increase rapid-
ly.

Von Houttei This is among the
hardest and most floriferous.
Neither of these need shearing, un-
less you clip some of the out-reach-
ing branches. Both kinds seem
made for hedges, as they naturally
shape themselves. This grows
readily from cuttings or divisions.

Opulifolia or Tree Spiraea: This
is by far the rankest of the whole
family. They have made five and
even six feet the first year, from
cuttings. The flowers are very
unique, a hemisphere in form. As
the name indicates, it is rich in
foliage. The flowers continue the
longest of any bloom. First they
are white, then they change to
yellow, gradually turning till the
seeds are ripened. Where you need
a vigorous, strong, ornamental
hedge, this will be the thing. It
grows readily from seeds or cut-
tings.

The Golden Spirea: This is a
sport or variation of the Opulifolia
and this makes a charming hedge.
The color is variable and shows
best in a dry season. Some years
the color seems to fade out badly
and as the hedge grows older the
color becomes dimmer. Yet it
does make a hardy and beautiful
hedge. It bears shearing, so you
can keep it in any form you like.

Tree Honeysuckles are growing
in favor with horticulturists.
They are generally planted sing-
ly, where they do not show to as
good advantage for this purpose
as when planted in a row. They
are very hardy, and it must be a
very severe and untimely freeze
which can affect them in the least.
In color, the bloom range from
white to dark rose.

The Ruprechtiana or Manchuria
is a very robust and hardy shrub,
fine in flower and showy in fruit.
Then there are the Chikensis, the
Orientalis, the Siberian, and five
different forms of the Tartarica,
also the Marrowi, which in the
east is the most popular of all on
account of its profusion of flowers
in great masses of berries which
peer out from the foliage. This
will need some shearing to keep it
in place as it is of a sprawling habit
and is much used to cover rocks,
clay banks, and to adorn unsightly
and rough grounds.

best of all, for its vigorous growth,
large flowers and showy fruit.
These grow from seed and also
grow readily from cuttings.

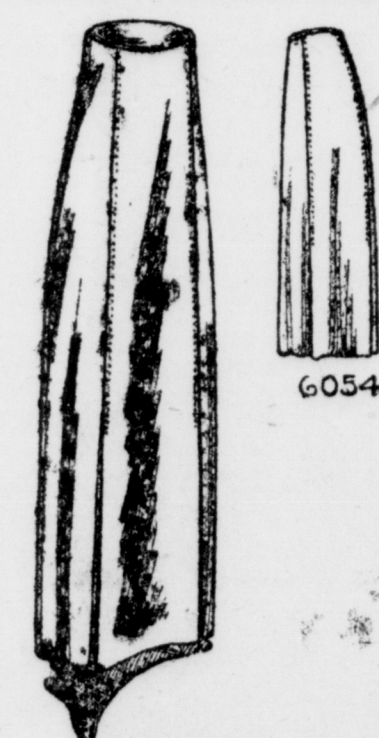
The California type of Privet or
Ligustrum which probably origi-
nated in Japan, is much used. It is
dwarfish in habit and retains its
foliage a long time, which is fresh
and green until the middle of Novem-
ber. The beautiful and charm-
ing Golden Privet is a sport of this
variety. It is of exquisite
beauty, especially after the first
frosts. Unfortunately, both are
a little tender some years. The
Common Privet has a silver type,
quite pronounced while young, but
when it gets age it reverts back to
the green.

The Regelliana is especially
beautiful with its fan-like system
of twigs, covered with beautiful
foliage. In form it is the most
striking of all.

The Ibotas is considered the
hardest. It is of Japanese origin.
The foliage is fine and remains
fresh till December. It is a very
tall, robust shrub. Unfortun-
ately, they all kill back more or less
in unfavorable seasons. They
should, if injured, be cut to the
ground, when they will grow up
into good form again. They are
raised from cuttings, only extreme
care must be used to secure them
before the heavy frosts.

The Burpina or purple Barberry
makes a very attractive hedge, and
will endure a good deal of shear-
ing. This has beautiful flowers
and purple fruit. The Vagalis
or common barberry is generally
used.

ing autumnal effect of its foliage
and enormous masses of fruit.

The Amour Barberry is con-
sidered by far the hardest and
best of all in some localities. It is
very vigorous and bears enormous
crop of berries which are said to
make good jams and jellies. All
these are raised from seed.

To pour a liquid into a small-mouthed
bottle moisten a wooden tooth-pick and
lay it across the top of the bottle from
which you are pouring, holding it there
with the forefinger. As you pour, the
liquid will run along the bit of wood into
