POTATO SCONES

Put two cupfuls of mashed potatoes into a bowl, add two tablespoonfuls of hot milk, one tablespoonful of melted butter one teaspoonful of sugar, a quarter of a teaspoonful of salt, and one cupful of flour. Knead, divide into three pieces and roll out into rounds. Divide each round into four small scones. Place them on a hot griddle and cook for five minutes on each side. Serve hot with butter.
