HOUSEHOLD.

Rice and Cheese.
Butter a baking dish, and in it
put alternate layers of rice and
grated cheese. Dissolve salt in a
little milk, and pour over the top.
Pat buttered crumbs on top and
bake in a hot oven ten or twenty
minutes.

Delicious Hermits.
Two cups of sugar, three eggs,
one cup of butter, one-half cup of
molasses, one cup of chopped rais-
ins, one cup of currants, one-fourth
cup of English walnut meats,
one-half cup of cold coffee,
one teaspoon soda dissolved in coffee
one tablespoon of cloves, two tea-
spoons cinnamon, four and one-
half to five cups of flour. Drop by
teaspoons on buttered tins.

Creamed Parsnips.
Wash, scrape and cut in slices
about one inch in thickness. Cook
until tender in just enough water
to cover. When done drain off the
water, if any remains, and remove
from saucepan. Place the pan on
the range with one cup of milk
and one tablespoon of butter. When
hot add to this one tablespoon of
flour stirred smooth with a little
cold milk. Let come to boiling
point, then add the parsnips. Sea-
son with salt and pepper. Stir all
together and serve.

Devil's Food Cake.
One-fourth cup of bitter choco-
late, one cup of sugar, one cup of
sour milk. Set over a slow fire,
melt and set aside. Cream one cup
of sugar, one-half cup of butter,
three eggs, two and one-half cups
of flour, one-half cup of sweet
milk, one teaspoon of soda, one-
half cup of hot coffee. Mix as fol-
lows: Cream butter and sugar, then
alternate sweet milk, coffee, flour
and chocolate until all are used ex-
cept flour. Then add the well
beaten yolks and the well beaten
whites, add extract and the re-
mainder of the flour.

To make chocolate filling for
devil's food cake: one-fourth cake
chocolate, one heaping cup of sug-
ar, one-fourth cup of butter, one-
half cup of sweet milk. Boil until
it thickens.

Fruit Cake.
One cup of granulated sugar,
one cup of brown sugar, one cup
of sweet butter, six eggs, one-half
cup orange juice, one-half cup of
New Orleans molasses, one cup
hickory nut meats, one and one-
half pounds of seeded raisins, one
pound of cleansed currants, one-
fourth pound of sweet almonds
blanched and cut in strips, two
ounces of citron cut in strips, one
teaspoon allspice, one teaspoonful
cloves, two teaspoons cinnamon,
one teaspoon nutmeg, one-half tea-
spoon soda dissolved in one table-
spoon water, one and one-half
pounds flour, one and one-half
teaspoons baking powder sifted
with the flour. Flour fruit well.
Add the rest of flour last. Bake
in pan lined with oiled paper two
and one-half hours in a moderate
oven.

When making garments for a
bazaar it is a good idea to roll the
scraps that are left into a little
bundle and fasten them to the gar-
ment.

**LAUNDERING HAND EM-
BROIDERY**

Great care should be exercised in
the washing and ironing of a piece
of hand embroidery.

The all-white pieces do not need
the care in washing as the ones
worked in colors.

For colored embroideries use a
suds made with tepid water and a
mild soap. Rinse twice, roll into a
clean muslin cloth and let stand
ten minutes.

Iron on the right side first, tak-
ing care that the material and de-
signs are pulled straight. Then
turn over on the wrong side and
press with full weight, using a hot
iron. The ironing should be done
on a table covered with six thick-
nesses of flannel and one of cot-
ton.

**A Stove Which Would Not
Cook.**

My new cook stove simply would
not bake. I had all manner of
trouble with it until a man of large
experience in the stove trade gave
me this hint: Put some fine sand
or ashes in the space under the
oven, also in the space over the oven.
After I did this, the sand re-
tained the heat; my oven baked to
a charm, and I saved no end of
fuel and vexation.—Mrs. V. K. M.,
in American Agriculturist.

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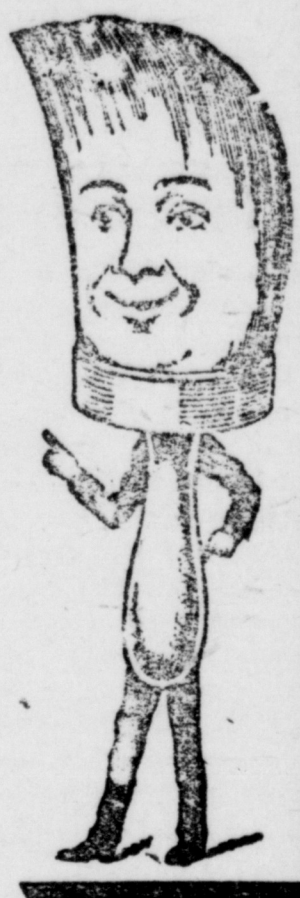
