

Hindus Must Give in to Inevitable

Ottawa, May 28.—Dr. Sunder Singh, leader of the British Columbia Hindus, who is in Ottawa to press the claims of his fellow countrymen who are seeking to enter Canada, had another interview today with Hon. Dr. Roche, Minister of Interior. He again urged that the Hindus should be allowed to enter the Dominion, on the ground of their British citizenship and because of the fact that most of those on board the Komgata Maru were old Sikh soldiers. While no threats were made, it was intimated that if the Hindus were not allowed to enter Canada freely, it might add to the unrest in India.

Dr. Singh again strongly urged that a Royal Commission be appointed to consider the whole question of immigration from India to Canada.

It is understood that the Government has no intention of receding from its position; and the law will be carried out to the letter in regard to the Hindus now quarantined at Vancouver. There is practically no chance of their being allowed to enter. While they may evade the order in council prohibiting the entrance of all artisans and laborers into British Columbia on the ground that they are farmers, they will be shut out under the regulation that they have not come by direct passage. The Hindus themselves admit that they did not sail direct from India.

A wire has been received from the counsel of the Hindus at Vancouver, asking that a number of those on board the ship be allowed to land for consultation purposes. He was notified that the question was entirely in the hands of Mr. Malcolm Reid, immigration agent at the coast.

It is estimated that the population of the United States is increasing at the rate of four thousand a day.

Insists he is not Able to Testify.

New York, May 27.—Wm. Rockefeller has returned to Tarrytown from Fairfield, Conn. Through friends it was said today that Mr. Rockefeller insists that he is not physically able to testify before the Interstate Commerce Commission, that his voice will not permit him to go on the stand, and so he considers the attempts to gain his testimony an annoyance. If anyone is to be subpoenaed for the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad, Mr. Rockefeller believes that it should be the auditors and bookkeepers, who know the details of the questions under inquiry by the commission.
