## HOUSEHOLD

## PEACH COBBLE.

Make a rich puff paste and line a deep porcelain dish. Fill with peeled and halved peaches sweetened and slightly stewed if desired. With ripe peaches, however, this is hardly desirable. Drop in three or four cracked peach pits. Cover with paste and bake in a quick oven. When done break the top crust lightly with a fork and mix with the peaches. Sprinkle powdered sugar over the top and serve with rich cream.

## BOILED CRACKED WHEAT.

Cracked whole wheat is one of the best cereals, but it must be correctly cooked. Lucky the housekeeper who has a 'fireless' cooker; if you do not have a fireless cooker start the wheat while getting the evening meal and boil all evening and let simmer all night. Enough can be cooked for two or three meals at a time; each warming over makes it better. One cup of wheat to 1 quart of water and 1 teaspoon salt make a good, stiff cereal. Where there is no fireless cooker a double boiler is used.

## CANNED SOUP.

One peck ripe tomatoes, good quality, peeled; half peck onions; one dozen medium sized carrots; three heads cabbage, three heads celery, one dozen ears corn, boiled for ten minutes on cob, then scraped from cob. Put all the above through meat chopper and mix together. Salt it according to taste, add small bunch parsley if desired. Cook until carrots are done, put hot in sealers. In the winter, add soup stock and serve. This is most wholesome and tasty, and preserves the full food value of the vegetables in their prime. Tomatoes may be omitted if not liked.

## STEAMED APPLES

Materials—Eight medium sized apples, 1-2 cup brown sugar, 1-4 teaspoon nutmeg. 1-2 cup water.

Wash and pare the apples, cut in half, put in pan cut side down, add the water, cover and put on quick fire until they boil; reduce the heat, add sugar and nutmeg, cover and cook until tender, but not broken. Serve in ice cream glasses.

## APPLE SAUCE CAKE.

Materials—1 cup brown sugar, 1-4 cup shortening, 1 cup sweetened apple sauce, 1 3-4 cups flour, 1 teaspoon baking soda, 1 teaspoon cinnamon, 1 teaspoon nutmeg.

Cream shortening and sugar together; stir the soda into the apple sauce and add sifted flour and spices to same. Line pan with paper and bake forty minutes in moderate oven. One-half cup chopped raisins or nuts may be added.

They are Canada's pledge to all the world that when Britain signs her name to a scrap of paper she will fulfill to the letter the terms of the contract. They are Canada's pledge that the interests of the Empire are her interests, and that the people of this free Dominion are prepared to fight for their rights and for the rights of mankind.

## The Wisdom of Bismarck.

(From "Conversations With Prince Bismarck," by Sir William B. Richmond in "North American Review.")

"The natural alliance is England, Germany and Italy. These three powers if placed upon a permanent war footing, would insure the peace of the world."

"In the next struggle with France which God forbid, we shall wait till her armies come to us. The French have raised such strong and so many fortifications since 70 that our advance would be out of the question."

"At the end of a repast in England years earlier I rose and proposed the following toast: 'For England a fleet that shall command the seas and an army for Germany that shall defy Europe—hence peace. And I think so now.'"

"I regarded the annexation of Alsace and Lorraine with misgivings. Mot-like insisted upon it as a necessity. Russia made a great mistake when she created another Poland for herself by taking Bessarabia."
