BIRD'S NEST PUDDING.

Core and pare eight apples; put into a deep, well-buttered pudding dish; fill centres with sugar and a little nut.xeg; add one pint of water and bake until tender, but not soft. To two cups of flour, add three teaspoonfuls of baking powder, one of salt, one pint of milk and well beaten yolks of four eggs; stir and fold in the whites of four eggs beaten dry. Pour over the apples and bake one hour, in moderate oven. Serve hot with any pudding sauce.

SOUR MILK WAFFLES.

Materials-Egg, 1; sour milk, 1 cup flour, 1 cup butter, 1 tablespoon soda, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1 1-2 teaspoons salt, 1-2 teaspoon.

Directions-Mix and sift flour, soda and baking powder. Beat egg thoroughly, add sour milk, flour and salt. Beat theroughly. Cook on bot waffle iron and serve hot with maple syrup.

Materials -- Breadcrumbs, 1 cup; milk, 1 cup; grated cheese, 1 cup; melted butter, 1 tablespoon; salt, 1-2 teaspoon; white pepper, 1-4 teaspoon; egg, 1.
