Strain this sauce over the eggs and rice dust with chopped parsley and serve very hot.

A NEW OMELET.

To make a tasty omelet cook two or three slices of bacon crisp and remove the meat. Fry in the bacon fat a slice of onion until it is golden brown and remove it. Turn in several lightly beaten eggs mixed with a little tomato pulp that has been drained from the liquor, the fried on ion and bacon slices chopped fine, season with paprika, and cook like an ordinary omelet.
