Honors For Woodstock Boy

The highest degree granted by McGill University, Montreal, that of Ph. D., has been given A. R. MacLean, M. Sc., lecturer in chemistry, son of Mrs. Chas. MacLean, 369 Mance, Montreal, formerly of this town.

Born twenty five years ago in Woodstock, New Brunswick, Dr. MacLean received his preliminary education at Woodstock High School. Entering McGill in 1907, he won scholarships in Chemistry in 1909 and 1910, and graduated with first rank honors in 1911. He became Master of Science in 1912, and since then has been on the staff of the chemical department. Throughout his college career his work has been of an especially high order, and has attracted much attention.

His Ph. D. thesis on "A colorimetric Method for the Estimation of Amino Acid Alpha Nitrogen," has been used by many prominent universities and colleges, and is highly mentioned by all chemical journals. Dr. MacLean is one of the youngest candidates who has ever been awarded this degree.
