Born twenty five years ago in Wood stock, New Brunswick, Dr. MacLean re ceived his preliminary education at Woodstock High School. Entering Mc Gill in 1907. he won scholarships in Che mistry in 1909 and 1910, and graduated with first rank honors in 1911. He be came Master of Science in 1912, and sin ce then has been on the staff of the che mical department. Throughout his col lege career his work has been of an es pecially high order, and has attracted much attention.

His Ph. D. thesis on "A colorimetric Method for the Estimation of Amino Acid Alpha Nitrogen," has been used by mary prominent universities and col leges, and is highly mentioned by all chemical journals. Dr. MacLean is one of the youngest candidates who has ever been awarded this degree.
