#### HOUSEHOLD

SPLIT-PEA SOUP

Material -- One cup split peas, 2 cups milk, 2 quart water, 1 small onion, small piece of ba con 2 tablespoons butter, 2 tablespoons floor salt and pepper.

Directions-Sook the peas overnight In the morning drain and put them in the stewpan with the cold water, bacon and oni n. Simmer several hours, or until soft enough to rub through the sieve. Cook the butter and flour together and add to the liquid. Season to taste. Serve with croutons of fried bread.

OMELET WITH TOMATO RICE

Materials-Four eggs, 4 tablespoons milk, 1 tablespoon butter, 1 cup boiled rice, 2 cups to mato sauce.

Directions-Beat the eggs add milk, salt and a dash et white pepper. Put butter in hot omelet pan, turn in the egg, mixture and cook until well set. Spread over it some hot rice which has been mixed with tomato sauce. Fold, turn on to a hot platter and pour the remainder of the tomato sauce around the omelet.

#### LEMON TARTS

Materials - One lemon, pound loaf sugar, 1 pound butter, yolks of 3 eggs, some pie-

Directions-Grate the rind and squeeze juice of lemon. Mix butter and sugar, add the beaten yolks of eggs, then the lemon juice and rind; mix well and let stand for a day or two. Line patty pans with pastry, put a little in each and bake in a hot

#### DATEWAFERS

Materials-One cup brown sugar, ½ cup sour milk, 1 cup shortening (scant), 21 cups each of oatmeal and flour, 1 teaspoon

Filling-One cup hot water, cup sugar, 1 pound dates, chopped and seeded; I teaspoon vanilla. Boil until it thickens.

Directions - Cream the sugar and shortening, add milk, then the oatmeal and lastly the flour, to which the soda has been added. Roll out very thin and bake in a quick oven. Put two cookies together with a layer of the date mixture between.

RAGOUT OF VEGETABLES

Materia's--One-fourth pound of salt pork, I sliced onion, I carrot, 2 potatoes, 1 cup each of peas and string beans, 1 ripe tomato, 1 cup stock, 1 tablespoon butter.

Directions—Parboil the pork with the vegetables; drain and slice; add stock, tomato and but-Season rather highly and cook one half hour.

#### Fresh German Troops Verdun
