


LONDON, Sept. 29.—British aviators dropped seven tons of explosives in at tacks Thursday night on German mili tary establishments in Belgium. The following is the statement given out to day by the admiralty:

"On the night of Sept. 27-28 there were bombing raids by naval aircraft on the following objectives. The lock gates at Zeebrugge, the St. Denis West rem airdrome, the Goatrode airdrome, the Houttave airdrome.


> Reporting aviation battles on the wes tern front, the war office says:

"On Thursday a heavy ground mist egain bindered aerial work, but our air planes continued to co operate with the artillery. Many hostile aerists were re connoitered and photographed during the day. Bombs were dropped by our airmen on the enemy's airdrome of Car nieree, St. Denis Westem, and Gon trode, on billets at Moors'ede and other targets. At night a total of six and three-quarters tons of bombs were drop ped on the following objectives: Gon trode airdrome, with good results; on





"In the course of these raids the Ger man troops and transports were success fully attacked by machine gun fire from our aircraft flying at a low altitude." In the air fighting several Germap mach ines were downed and three others were driven down out of control. One was shot down by our infantry fire.
