## HOUSEHOLD

## FRENCH MUTTON STEW

Take 1½ lbs. of neck or shoul-  
der of mutton, cut in pieces, five  
cents' worth of carrots and tur-  
nips, 2 onions and a sprig of  
parsley. Brown a tablespoon of  
flour with about the same quan-  
tity of butter. When brown, add  
meat, then the vegetables cut in  
rounds—put 1 clove in one of the  
onions—add pepper, salt and  
2 cups of cold water. Cover  
tight and simmer 2 hours. One  
hour before serving add a few  
potatoes to the stew.

## FRIED LIVER WITH ONIONS

Lay your sliced liver in pan,  
pour boiling water over to take  
out as much blood as possible.  
Take out, roll each piece in flour,  
have frying pan ready with lard  
or meat fryings in already heat-  
ed; lay in each piece, salt and  
pepper, cover and fry slowly. Of  
course turn over when half done.Fry onions in another pan,  
and when liver is done pour  
them over liver after it is on the  
platter or slice onions on top of  
the liver while cooking. When  
half done take pancake turner  
and turn over each piece, onions  
and liver.

## SOUR MILK GEMS

1 cup of sour milk, 1 egg,  
½ cup of molasses, ½ tablespoon  
of shortening (lard, butter or  
drippings), ½ teaspoon of soda  
and a little salt. Mix together  
1 cup of white flour and 1 of  
graham flour, and stir into the  
other ingredients. Rye meal or  
granulated corn meal may be  
used instead of the graham. I  
use the old-fashioned iron gem  
pan. Grease it and heat it smok-  
ing hot and drop the batter in  
and bake. This is just enough  
for a dozen gems.

## BAKED HAM

Instead of boiling ham try  
baking it, after first soaking it  
in several lukewarm waters, then  
dry, and put in pan, pour milk  
pretty near to cover it. Bake un-  
til brown, about ½ to 1 hour.

## MEAT LOAF

1 lb. hamburger steak. Add to  
it 2 cups of cracker crumbs, pep-  
per and salt, 1 small onion, 1 tea-  
spoon of seasoning, a little fat  
salt pork cut fine. Add water  
until quite soft pack in pan and  
bake until done, basting if dry.**School Report for**
