Coun Smith—The committee met last Monday night and Engineer Grimmer explained a scheme for taking a census of the water tanks by dividing the town into lots. It was absolutely necessary to have such a census taken.

Moved by Couns Smith and Leighton that the matter be left to the water committee to arrange, if it is thought necessary, with Engineer Grimmer for the work.

Mayer Burt—Mr. Hay of Millville says he is prepared to put in 10,000 cords of wood into town. He is willing to give the town the preference. If the town does not want any wood, the brick kiln will buy all the wood he has.
