**George W Banks**

On Sunday May 12th, Mr. George W. Banks passed away at his home in Bristol, N. B. Deceased was in the 75th year of his age. He was born in East Florenceville where he lived for many years and afterwards moved to Bristol. He was well known in early life as a lumberman, but was obliged to give up labor on account of rheumatism from which he was a great sufferer for many years.

Mr. Banks was a man of kind heart and christian faith and took a keen interest in public affairs. He is survived by his wife formerly Miss Ruth Gilmour of Esdrael, N. B., by whom he leaves four sons; Hiram, William, Stafford and John all of Bristol; seven daughters; Mrs. Harry Snow, Mrs. Bessie Mitchell and Miss Maud of Worcester, Mass., Mrs. A. D. Bailey, Mrs. Walter Bailey and Mrs. James Bell of Fredericton, and Mrs. E. Scott of Esdrael, and a number of grandchildren. He is also survived by one brother William of Brookfield Mass.

The funeral was held on Tuesday afternoon, Rev. M. H. Mannel officiating. The remains were taken to Esdrael for burial.

**Mr. W. P. Hayden**

The death occurred on Sunday, April 22nd, of Mr. W. P. Hayden, after a week's illness of pneumonia, aged 79 yrs. He is survived by his wife, one daughter Mrs. Frank R. Marshall, of Oshkosh, Wis., two sons, William J. Hayden and John F. Hayden of Montana, one sister, Mrs. Kate Parks, of Richmond, and five grand children, beside a large circle of relatives and friends. The funeral took place on Thursday afternoon, May, 2nd. After a prayer service at the home the remains were taken to St. Luke's church, where service was conducted by the Rev. A. S. Hazel. The pall-bearers were T. C. L. Ketchum, Hon. W. P. Jones, J. N. W. Winslow and James Brown. Interment was in the parish church cemetery. There were beautiful flowers from relatives and friends.
