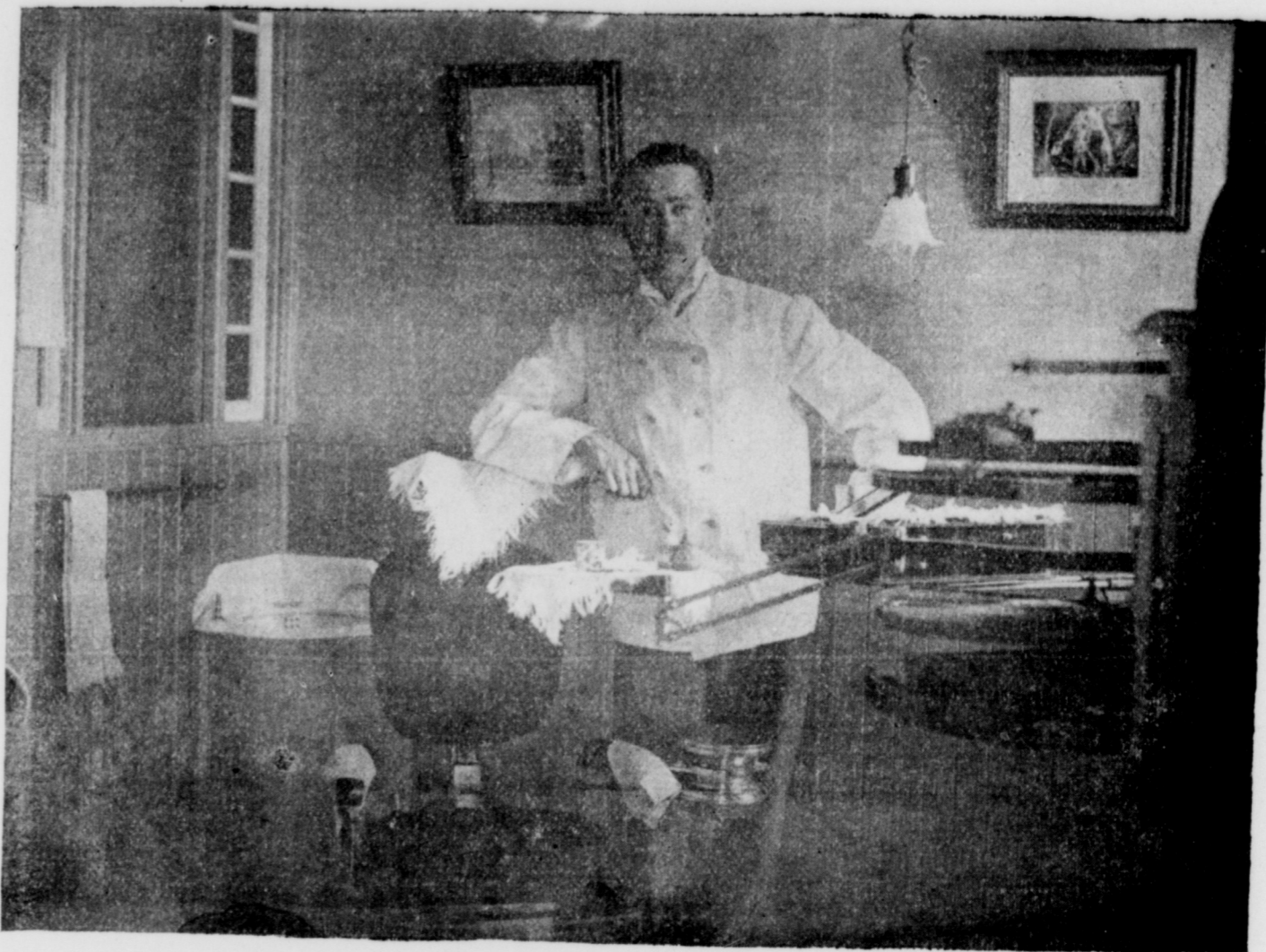
DR. G. B. MANZER.
