PROVINCIAL EXHIBITION.

We publish the list of the prizes, in money, diplomas, and honorable mentions awarded at the Provincial Exhibition. Our readers will no doubt find interest in scanning it over. In the way of prize taking, whether by money or diploma, Fredericton did very well, but it must be said that York and the up river Counties and Charlotte did not. Sunbury in sheep, horses and swine held its own. The prize list proves that the locality of an Exhibition decides what part of the Province will be best represented. St. John city and county, King's, Kent, and in lesser degree Westmorland and Albert carried off the bulk of the prizes. The manufacturers and exhibitors of agricultural implements, the florists and horticulturists and lady workers in fancy articles from Fredericton, carried off a good number of tokens of success. In oats, barley, buckwheat, grass, (Timothy), a prize or two went to Kingsclear, Stanley, Woodstock and Jacksonville.
