Town and Country.

Our St. John contemporaries will always find our local news full and reliable, but we would ask some of them to give the usual credit.

Mr. Joust, wife of Mr. Beverly R. Joust, Esq., and sister of the late Judge Wilson, died on Saturday. Her remains were interred on Monday and the funeral was largely attended.

We learn that Mr. Lynch, the well known lumberer, who is operating on the Miramichi, from Burnt Hill, northwards, intends taking out ten millions of lumber this season. He has now forty teams in the woods.

Oats are selling up river, at 42 cents a bushel, and they may fetch 80 cents before the winter closes. Mr. Wm. H. Murray, purchased on Monday, 8,000 bushels, at 42 cents, and also a large quantity of hay, which is selling for \$11 a ton, from the cars.

Hon. Mr. Crawford, Solicitor General, left here yesterday for Philadelphia, hoping that the change in climate will benefit his health which has been in an indifferent state of late. He was accompanied by Gilbert R. Pugsley, Esq., the senior partner of the legal firm of Pugsley, Crawford, Pugsley & Legrain, of St. John.

Alderman Burchill has returned home from a trip to New York. While there he was prospecting with a view of removing to that City to start in business, but he has not fully made up his mind, as yet, what he will do. If he decides to remain here he will in all probability again be a candidate for the Council.

The rash of people to the Clearance Sale of the Stock of the late R. M. McDonald continues, and especially so, as the wind is blowing up the business, is offering better bargains than ever. It is determined to get rid of the entire stock next month, and to that end will almost sacrifice his fine selection of goods.

Messrs. C. G. D. Roberts, A. B., and A. W. Wilkinson, A. B., Principals of Chatham and Saint Andrews Grammar Schools respectively, are home for the holidays. The former is understood, before returning to Chatham, will be principal in an interesting ceremony, to be performed in the Cathedral not many days hence.

The members of the Board of Agriculture, which met here last week, have been very self-sensible to grapple successfully with the great and all-important problems with which they were called upon to deal. Without exception they are gentlemen of intelligence, energy and industry, and it is to be hoped that what is indispensable to the successful guidance of any deliberative body, the meetings of the Board, we trust, and the subjects discussed there we feel quite sure will be productive of the greatest good to our agricultural population.

Almost every day we hear of the return of young men to this City from Boston, whether they removed last spring, hoping to better their condition. They are glad to get back, and we are glad to welcome them, and impress their experience upon others, who may, as Mr. Wedderburn puts it, "contemplate joining the grand army of grumblers, who annually leave this Province for the States." From what we can learn, many of the young men were given to the same old employment, and when it did come the remuneration was so meagre as to be scarcely sufficient to sustain life. The visions of good positions with lucrative salaries, that had floated before their minds, proved utterly unavailing to entrap them into eking a miserable existence in a strange country, when at home they might have been enjoying comparative comfort and independence. What they have learned will certainly be a lesson to others, and are not content until they have scraped together every possible dollar to leave their homes. In most cases the young men take away more money than they brought to the Province not only less the benefit of their labor while absent, but in a financial point of view is also stripped. We are not speaking generally, but we have had instances that will fully bear out what we have written. Let anyone ask those young men, and if they tell the truth their story must be even stronger than what have reported.
