

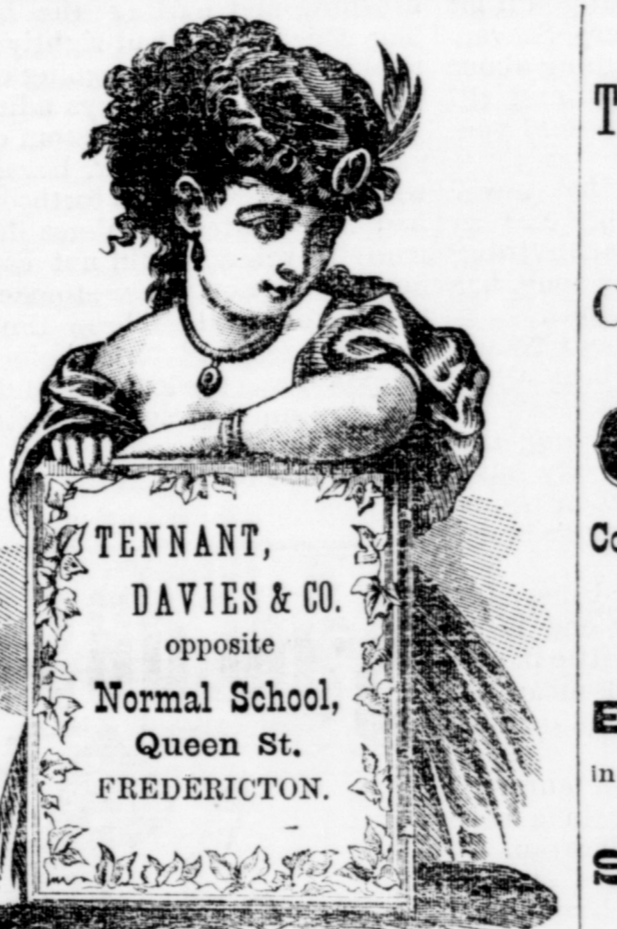
Town and Country.
