

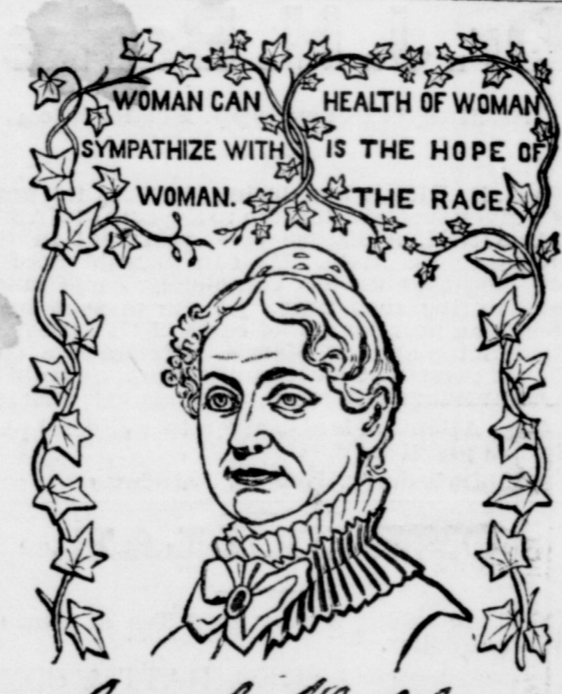
A MONSTROUS WRONG.
