Found Drowned. A correspondent writes: "On Tuesday last, a boy living at James Taylor's, Ruskaghorn, named Guy McConathy, aged 12 years, left home about six o'clock, P. M., accompanied by a dog, to bring home the cows, and not returning before dark, he was sought for by his father and a horse was blown and a search made at once. The dog returned about eight o'clock without his little master. The case was still more alarming, and the search was kept up until Saturday evening without success, when news came that the boy had been seen in Fredericton, but the report proved untrue. On Sunday afternoon, Mr. Connolly was walking along the bank of the Ruskaghorn stream, about one mile below the railroad bridge, and observed the body floating in the water, and assisted by Mr. Stevens, he secured it. The body was found to be that of the boy, and was taken to the Municipal Council building, where it was held for a few days, until it was buried in the cemetery on Friday."

Deaths. In this city, on the 20th ult., Mrs. Christopher Brown, aged 72 years, died at her residence, 25 St. John Street, of cholera. She was the widow of the late Mr. John Brown, and was the mother of Mr. James Brown, of the same address. She was a native of Scotland, and had resided in this city for many years. Her death was the result of a sudden attack of cholera, which she contracted while on a visit to her relatives in the country. She was buried in the cemetery on Friday.
