The Case of Riel.

The judicial committee of the English Privy Council, gave judgment in Riel's case on Thursday last, dismissing the appeal and affirming the rebel's conviction ; holding (1) that the Canadian Court in which he was tried and convicted, had jurisdiction, (2) that a jury of six men was sufficient, (3) that short hand notes were lawful reports of the proceedings, and, (4) that substantial justice had been done Riel.

A London cablegram says that the decision as to Riel's application for leave to appeal is quite in accordance with the general anticipation there in legal circles. The potitioner's case was considered very weak from the outset. Riel's counsel relied chiefly on the contention that the Court in the first instance at Regina, had no jurisdiction to try the petition. The Court apparently was not much disposed to attach weight to this argument. No surprise was felt when at the close of the counsel's address the Attorney-General said he did not feel called upon to reply Act has not restricted the sale of liquor on behalf of the Crown.
