### THE TRIAL AT WINCHESTER, VA.

The trial at Winchester, Va., last month, of T. A. Ridenour, charged with the murder of Andrew Broy, resulted in a verdict of acquittal. The case is a remarkable one in the history of criminal trials. The murdered man and the accused were intimate friends, and the evidence was almost entirely of a circumstantial character. The murder was committed over two years ago, and the first trial resulted in a conviction of murder in the first degree, but the verdict was set aside by Judge Clark of the County Court, on proof that during the trial several letters, though of a private nature, had been permitted to reach one or more of the jurors. A second trial was had, and this, also, resulted in a verdict of murder in the first degree, and sentence of death was passed and the day of execution fixed. Counsel for defence then took the case before Circuit Judge Turner on a large number of exceptions, which he over-ruled all the exceptions, but granted a new trial for the reason that the clerk in making up the record inserted an extra initial in the name of Andrew Broy, the murdered man. But for this clerical error it is probable Ridenour would have been acquitted. As above stated, the third trial has resulted in the acquittal of Ridenour. The jury was composed of well known citizens and the verdict was rendered within an hour after the case had been given into their hands.
