

the names of all ratable persons, and the valuation of the property and income of each person, which list is posted for ten days for the purpose of correction. Any person who objects that his own real or personal property or income is over valued may then appeal to the Board of valuers in writing, who, on receiving such objections shall set aside a day for their consideration. After this the assessment list is completed and filed with the clerk of the Peace.

As not only the Parish and County rates but also the District school assessment is levied from the assessors' valuation it is important that it be properly made up, and that any errors in the appraisement &c., be corrected before the list goes out of the assessors' hands.

Milton's Foreigner.

On Friday night last, in the Commons at Ottawa, Mr. Mitchell displayed that ignorance of New Brunswick affairs which his absence from the Province and of any personal interest in it, save such as may secure his election when he wants it, are calculated to intensify. The Bill to provide for Municipal Government in Keewatin was being discussed and the Opposition occupied nearly the whole night in opposing the introduction of voting by ballot. Mr. Baby said that neither New Brunswick nor Nova Scotia had yet adopted the municipal system and that the Municipal Act of New Brunswick was a permissive act, a statement which Hon. A. J. Smith corrected by stating that the law was compulsory and that all the Counties of the Province were incorporated under it.

Mr. Mitchell said that was not the case and that only a few Counties in New Brunswick were yet under incorporation. He went on at some length to substantiate what Mr. Baby had said. Several New Brunswick members corrected him and Mr. Holton said that Mr. Mitchell's statements were not to be considered, as he was a foreigner to his own constituency.

They evidently understand Mr. Mitchell pretty well at Ottawa.
