According to this theory, he gains; we certainly would not lose the \$2,000. Even \$2,000 is more than we should be required to pay unfairly, and if the people of New Brunswick think they are treated unfairly because they pay a sixth less on every pound of tea than the people of Ontario, they should demand redress.

He spoke also of the great injustice a specific duty does to the poor man, who, if he uses very cheap tea--and, by the way, our working people, generally, like good tea--pays on tea costing 17 cents, about 30 per cent., while the very rich or the very choice tea pay only about ten per cent.

The other part of the story about tea, was that the imposition of a duty of ten per cent, on tea not imported directly, built up a great domestic tea trade and encouraged the shipping interest, and that the abolition of that duty forced a large number of merchants to remove their business to the United States.
