SYNOPSIS OF THE CANADA TEMPERANCE ACT.

This Act was passed by the Parliament of Canada in the Session of 1878, and received the assent of the Governor General on the 10th of May that year. The object is to promote Temperance in the Dominion, and secure a uniform legislation in all the Provinces respecting the traffic in Intoxicating Liquors.

PRELIMINARY STEPS. The first step to be taken in any County where the submission of the Act is desired, is to obtain the signatures of at least one-fourth of the Dominion electors to a petition, when duly signed, is to be deposited with the Sheriff or Registrar of deeds, for public examination for ten days, then forwarded to the Governor-General through the Secretary of State, with evidence that the necessary forms have been complied with.

THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT. RETAIL. When the Act has been adopted and in force, it closes at once and thoroughly all shops for the sale of intoxicating liquors, except for three purposes.

WHOLESALE. No person can sell by wholesale, except he have a license therefor from the local licensing authority, and be a person exclusively engaged in some wholesale trade.
