the card to keep up their courage. When a correspondent of the Monitor called himself a "Contributable" it was but the old game of his trying to play the lion.

It would be waste of valuable time to unmask "Contributable" and make him answer for his libels in a Law Court; and then, again, there are persons whose mental and financial irresponsibility being sufficient answer to legal prosecutions, would make it inadvisable to undertake such proceedings.

Children at play, when they lose an arrow, shoot another in the air and hope to find the lost one where they follow falls. I will be surprised if such a simple expedient do not show your readers the hiding place of "Contributable."
