\$75,000 Capital Prize Won and Paid

A Kingston, Ont., despatch of Thursday last gives particulars of a horrible fatality which occurred the day before at Yarker. A mile north of Yarker, Adlington County, four men were sitting around a camp fire thawing out fifteen pounds of dynamite in cartridges when a burning brand fell upon one of the cartridges, and ignited it. The men ran when warned to do so, but two of them returned and attempted to save the dynamite. They picked up a couple of the cartridges, but had no sooner done so than they exploded, one of the men being blown twelve feet, and so mangled that he only lived five minutes. His hands, legs, and part of his face were blown away. The other man lost a hand and leg. Two of the group having got some distance away escaped injury.

The five men at Sambre Island who manned the rescuing boat the morning after the disaster to the steamer Daniel Steinmann are to be presented by the Belgian government with gold medals in the form of a Maltese cross with the King of the Belgians' monogram in the centre and suspended by a ribbon of the national colors.
