CHINESE ATTACKED AND MURDERED BY WHOLESALE—BURNED TO DEATH AND DRIVES TO THE HILLS. OMAHA, Neb., Sept. 3, 1885.—A terrible riot, resulting in the loss of several lives, occurred yesterday afternoon at Rock Springs, Wyo. THE PELLER MURDER. IS PELLER DEAD OR ALIVE?—VIEWS OF A BOSTON DOCTOR WHO KNEW BOTH HIM AND HIS ALLEGED MURDERER. BOSTON, Aug. 30.—The young English surgeon, Dr. H. Graham Dewey, who has been practicing medicine in Boston for some years and who is referred to in the letter received a day or two ago by Maxwell, the alleged murderer of Peller in St. Louis, which purports to have been written by Peller himself from Wilkes-Barre, Pa., states that he knows nothing of the letter in question or of the St. Louis mystery.

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THE HANOVERIAN. ST. JOHN'S, N.B., Sept. 4.—Advice from Trepassy state that divers examined the wreck of the Hanoverian to-day and found the red, black and rudder post cleaned from the stern, and the cargo rushing out through two vast gaping holes. The damage ascertained is fatal, and the bottom of the ship is embedded in ragged rocks.
