Miramichi Advance.

There was universal satisfaction on the Miramichi over the result of the election for mayor of St. John last week. The candidates were Messrs. Chas. A. Everitt, ex-M. P. and Geo. A. Barker. Mr. Barker had entered the field some time before Portland and St. John were united as the new and enlarged city, and Mr. Everitt was not known to be an aspirant for the position until after the union was consummated.

A few years ago it was patched up, and the cracking walls were tied together with iron tie-rods. Since that time it has taken a new lurch here, a kink there, and a bulge-out somewhere else, until it is almost dangerous to approach.
