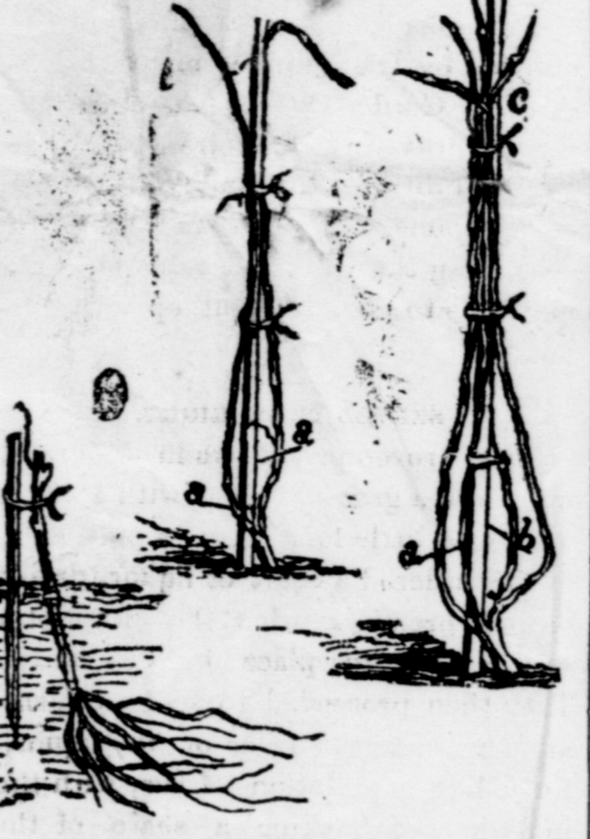

CULTURE OF THE GRAPE--FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD YEAR.

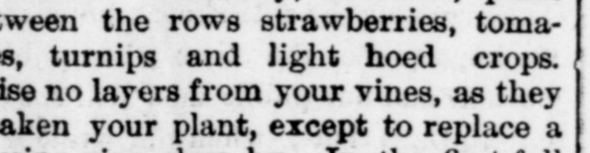
Thoroughly plow and pulverize the ground about eighteen or twenty-four inches deep, and on steep hillsides even deeper.
