ROUGH VOYAGE TO F. E. ISLAND.

Courtesy of the Canadian Editors--The Annapolis Settlement Hard to Find--Lieutenant Governor McLelean--Premier W. S. Fielding and Speaker Power.

I must not leave Nova Scotia without some acknowledgment of the many courtesies received. The Canadian Press Association (most of the editors in it are located in Ontario) made its two days' visit to Halifax during my stay.

The conclusion of the whole matter may be thus set down: One-half of Nova Scotia consists of very fertile valleys, in which are produced in great abundance nearly all the fruits, roots and grains of the temperate zone.
