A PLEA FOR WISE DISCRIMINATION IN THE MAKING OF ROADS.

Cheap and Costly Roads--Why the Cost Should be Proportionate to the Benefits Expected--How Farmers May Aid the Good Work at Small Expense.

The increased interest which is felt by country residents at large in the importance of good roads, is indicated by the general discussion on the subject; but the general difference of opinion as to the best means to employ in bringing about a general improvement is likely to cripple the work.

ROAD SURFACE WITH MIDDLE CURVE. For many miles of good road surfaces Roads with a rounded surface soon wear hollow in the middle and hold the water to make mud holes.

How to Make Gravel Roads. Good gravel roads exist in great abundance throughout the villages and towns of Massachusetts.

ROAD DRAINAGE. The one thing necessary to a good road--earth, gravel, macadam, or paved--is thorough drainage of the foundation.
