The bricks serve as double windows, giving protection against both cold and heat : they are good insulators of humidity and noise ; and they lend themselves readily

to the decoration of buildings either by their form or their color. Many applications are foreseen. The bricks are neater than marble in meat markets, and are especially adapted for bath halls, hot


