REPEATED INVOICES. Two items in our summary are deserving of more than the passing notice they may receive in that shape. A firm of milk agents is reported as seeking title for the insolvent Court for the third time in about five years, and another firm for the fourth time. If these were solitary instances, or of very rare occurrence, it would answer no purpose to direct attention to them. But, unfortunately, they are not. These repeated insolvencies of the same persons are so common as to have become a marked feature of our commercial life. We ourselves have called attention to them again and again. We have protested repeatedly against the folly of trusting a man who has recently failed, on the ground that he is certainly good for a time at any rate. We have urged that there should be discrimination against those who have failed even once, as all experience has shown that the same re-
