MEETING THE NOVA SCOTIA CHALLENGE. It would be remembered also that last year when the issue was in committee of supply the honorable leader of the Opposition had sought to create the impression that we were paying much more for public printing than was paid in the provinces of Nova Scotia.

AGRICULTURE AND AGRICULTURE. With reference to the matter of agriculture Mr. Tweedie said that the expenditure had been \$19,395.84 or \$4,763.17 less than the estimate.

EDUCATION. The excess of expenditure upon the service of education was very large, amounting to no less a sum than \$14,482.52. Perhaps the best explanation he could give of that was to quote from the annual report of the Chief Superintendent of Education, as given upon page 33.

TO THE CLOSURE OF THE YEAR 1896, the provincial grants to teachers were paid in two equal annual payments, thus giving to those who taught only 90 days during the year...

With regard to the estimate upon Education the Government were governed by the decision of the Chief Superintendent, who made a statement of the requirements for each year...

ANY PROVINCE IN CANADA, still be thought of as a public spirited citizen in the Province was in favor of preventing the cause of education throughout every district in the Province.

FISHING AND GAME PROTECTION. The cost of fishery protection had exceeded the expectation of the Government by \$70.50 and of game protection by \$282.

At this time there was pressing need for the appointment of 30 or 40 extra wardens to prevent the killing of moose and caribou in the deep snows that prevailed all over the Province this winter.

NEW ROADS. There were being built, and new emergencies were arising from time to time, which no Government could ignore that professed to regard the true interests of the people.

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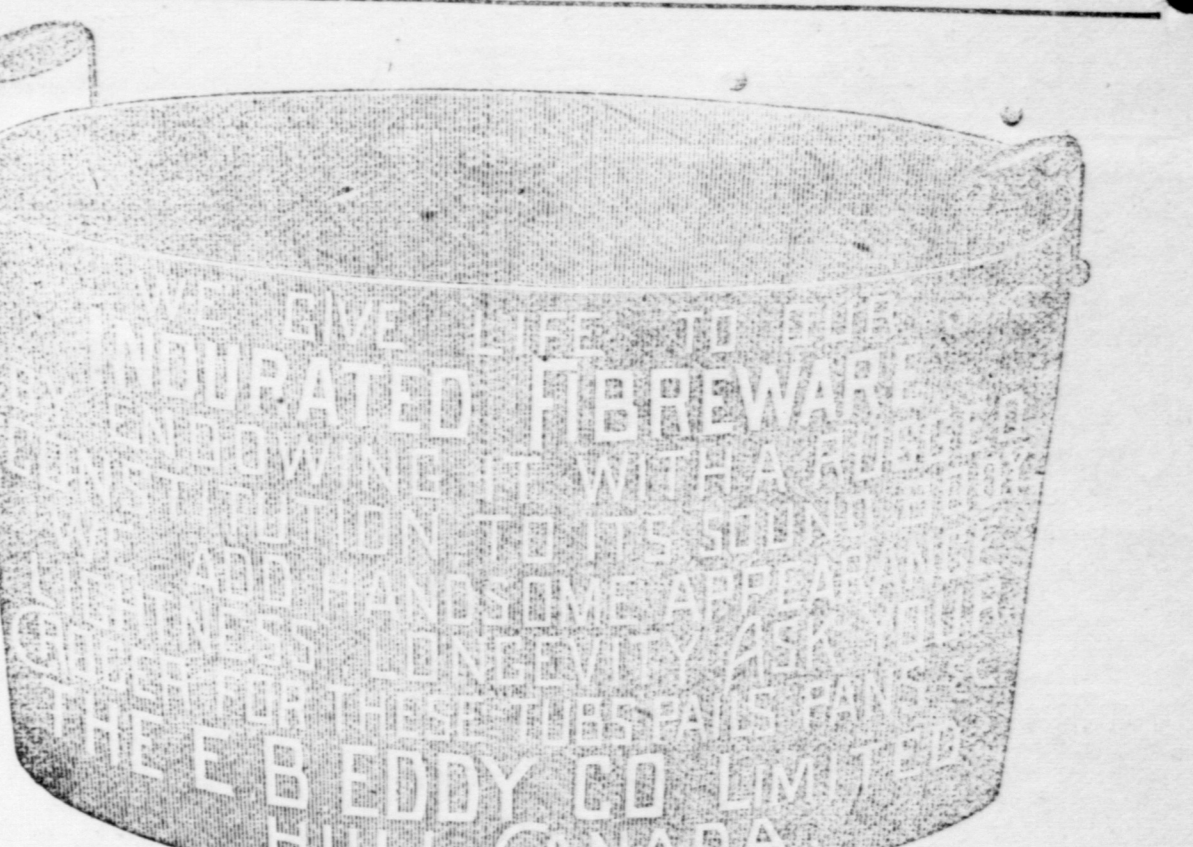
