NOTICE TO HOLDERS OF TIMBER LISENCES

The attention of all holders of Timber Licenses is called to Section 19 of the Timber Regulations which reads as follows: "The holder of a license shall be bound to observe the following conditions: 1. No stump of a tree shall be cut by any licensee under any license, not even for firewood, which will not make a log at least 18 feet in length and ten inches at the small end, and which shall be cut in such a manner that the lumber shall be liable to double stumps and the license be forfeited."
