The Change in the School Year. As the Act of Assembly passed at the late session amending the School Act is of general interest, we publish it for the information of the readers of the ADVANCE:

GAP. XXVII. An Act to amend "The School Act, 1900."

Section 1. The School Term, which will expire on the 30th day of June next, the Act in force on the 1st day of January, 1900, and by the provisions of "The School Act, 1900," the next school year begins on the first day of July, 1901, and by reason thereof it is necessary to make provision for the collection of a Poll Tax for the interim Term, which began on the first day of January last, and will end on the 30th day of June next.

Shamrock II. Sir Thomas Lipton's new challenger, Shamrock II was launched on Saturday last at Dartmouth, in presence of an assemblage of invited guests, newspaper representatives and others.
