



REMOVING DANDRUFF.

Scalp massage will overcome danbrushing the scalp thoroughly every night, massage with the fingers or massage roller. Once a week use the following wash: Powdered borax, two ounces, powdered camphor, one ounce; boiling water, two quarts. When cold bottle for use. Never use any preparation for face or scalp from the bottle but always turn out enough for one treatment in a small saucer or dish. Rub this well into the roots of the hair and follow by a vigorous brushing with a scrupulously clean hair-brush.
