Queen Victoria's Death.

In her eighty-second year, Queen Victoria, who reigned over the world's greatest Empire for nearly sixty-four years, is dead.

It is not within the scope of a merely local weekly, such as the ADVANCE, to deal with the events which have moulded the destinies of the great powers of the world in the Victorian age.

Her life, as the Queen of Britain, has been one of unexampled devotion to the duties of that exalted and responsible position.

Queen Victoria's successor on the throne will naturally be influenced by the principles, incentives and precedents which guided her as the Sovereign of the most potent of earthly powers.

Last Thursday Her Majesty had a stroke of paralysis and in a comatose condition until Tuesday evening when she passed from life painlessly and without a struggle.

The private council and parliament were at once summoned. At the Privy Council meeting the ministers have already attended and given up their seals of office to be re-sworn, receive the proclamation of the new King, have the seals returned to them, pass votes of condolence and congratulation and then adjourn.
