SHAREHOLDERS' MEETING.

The Sixty-eighth Annual Meeting of the shareholders of the British America Assurance Company was held at its offices, Toronto, on Thursday, the 27th inst.

ANNUAL REPORT.

Your Directors have pleasure in presenting the Sixty-eighth Annual Report and Financial statements, duly vouched for by the Auditors of the Company.

There has been a moderate increase in the Premium Income in all branches, the Canadian Fire Business, particularly, showing a considerable increase over that of any previous year, this being mainly due to the advanced rates which have been obtained.

The balance of Revenue Account, \$99,590.00, has been applied as follows:- \$65,000.00 for two half-yearly dividends, the first at the rate of Six Per Cent. on the rate of Six Per Cent. per annum, \$4,015.28 written off furniture and Securities, and the balance, \$30,544.72, added to the Reserve Fund, which now stands at \$612,001.96.

Although considerable progress has been made during the year in the direction of advancing rates throughout Canada and the United States, the result of the business, owing to the increase in fire losses, has not proved satisfactory to Companies generally, and measures are now being taken for further advances which should bring about a material improvement in the condition of the fire insurance business on this continent.
