The House resumed business at 4.30. Hon. Mr. Tweedie presented the petition of Philip Cox and others for a bill to incorporate the Miramichi Natural History Association.

Mr. Johnson presented the petition of Urban Johnson and others for an amendment to the liquor license act of 1896.

Mr. Hazen introduced a bill respecting the land of landlord and tenant. He explained that it was intended to avoid a difficulty arising out of distress for rent.

Now a landlord can seize the goods of a lodger and sell them under distress. The bill will provide that where goods are seized the lodger may make a declaration that the goods are his and tender the amount he owes the tenant, if anything, to the landlord, upon which his goods will be released.

Mr. McLachlan presented the petition of George Haddow and others for the incorporation of a District for water, fire, sewerage, light and police purposes.

Mr. Morrison introduced a bill to exempt the Aiton mill near Redbank, South E. from taxation.

The Hon. Mr. Dunn in reply to Mr. Hazen said the reason for abandoning the petition withholding the Upsalquitch river from the sale of fishing rights is that the experience which the department had during the past year, when it was not leased, was not satisfactory.

The total number of persons who fished upon the river last season was 24, and the total revenue derived was \$185, less expenses of \$18.50, or a net sum of \$171.50.

The amount paid by the province for protection was \$672, thus making a net loss to the province of \$970.50.

In answer to the last portion of the question, as to whether the government is of opinion that all the fishing rivers in the province shall be leased for terms of years to the exclusion of citizens of the province and tourists who are willing to pay moderate fees for their enjoyment, and the government has not arrived at a fixed conclusion with regard to it.
