Lord Dundonald Must Go. At a recent banquet, Lord Dundonald, the commander-in-chief of the Canadian Militia made a politically injudicious speech. A part of it was as follows: "Recently, gentlemen, a gross instance of political interference has occurred. I sent a list of officers of the 13th Light Dragoons to the Gazette. I was astonished to receive the list back with the name of one officer scratched out and initialed by the Minister of Agriculture, Hon. Sydney Fisher."

Monday's news shows that the Japanese are making free use of their naval forces along the shores of the Liaoting peninsula. The squadron in the Gulf of Pechili is blockading Newchwang and patrolling the coast to the southward. The Manchurian railway runs along the shore there and Admiral Togo reports that the other day one of his ships bombarded a railway train near Kaichow and forced it to turn back.

Friday will be a very busy day. In the morning will take place the landing of Champlain, deMente and Pontrevert at the market slip. The arrangements for this event are in the hands of the Neptune Rowing Club who will have a ship of the period, the 16th century, and a whole host of canoes manned by Indians.
