Sydney Fraser, Minister of Agriculture, has authorized the live stock commissioner to announce that any Canadian who exhibits horses, cattle, sheep, swine, or poultry at the St. Louis exposition, will receive such services as are granted to exhibitors in other classes, and in addition the Department of Agriculture will pay to each such exhibitor an amount equal to the prize money which he secured in the competition for which he enters.
