It is not quite two years since the United Kingdom was convulsed to its centre by the attempt of Pope Pius the ninth to exercise spiritual authority there, by parcelling out the country into Provinces and Bishoprics, and appointing certain ecclesiastics to preside over them, under the title of Archbishops and Bishops of such territorial divisions. The nation very justly considered such an assumption to be an encroachment upon the Sovereign power of the Queen, the Protestantism of England, and the Protestant Established Church. It felt itself aggrieved and insulted, and a law was as speedily as possible pressed through Parliament, giving expression to this feeling. By this enactment it is declared, that the attempt to establish, under color of authority from the See of Rome, or otherwise, any See, Province or Diocese, in the United Kingdom, shall be illegal and void. The first clause enacts, that all briefs, rescripts, or letters apostolical, and all authority and title conferred thereby, shall be deemed unlawful. A heavy penalty is imposed, in the second clause, upon any person who shall assume, or use the name, style, or title of any city town or place, or of any territory or district, under awy designation or description whatever, in the United Kingdom.
